- (b) if, in a case where an application is made to the court for a Part VII order in relation to a child, a person alleges that there has been abuse of a child or family violence or there is a risk of abuse of a child or family violence and the allegation of abuse, family violence or risk of abuse or family violence is relevant to whether the court should grant or refuse the application (Section 67ZBA of the Family Law Act 1975, and Rule 2.04D(1)(a) of the Family Law Rules 2004).

NOTE: If you are applying for parenting orders by filing an Application for Consent Order use the Notice of Child Abuse, Family Violence or Risk of Family Violence (Application for Consent Orders).

Section 4(1) of the Family Law Act states as follows:

Abuse, in relation to a child, means:

- (a) an assault, including a sexual assault, of the child; or
- (b) a person (the **first person**) involving the child in a sexual activity with the first person or another person in which the child is used, directly or indirectly, as a sexual object by the first person or the other person, and where there is an unequal power in the relationship between the child and the first person; or
- (c) causing the child to suffer serious psychological harm, including (but not limited to) when that harm is caused by the child being subjected to, or exposed to, family violence; or
- (d) serious neglect of the child.

A family violence order is an order (including an interim order) made under a prescribed law of a state or territory to protect a person from family violence.

Family violence means:

- violent, threatening or other behaviour by a person that coerces or controls a member of the person's family (the **family member**), or causes the family member to be fearful; and
- a child is exposed to family violence if the child sees or hears family violence or otherwise experiences the effects of family violence (Section 4AB).

NOTE: The Registry Manager **must** provide a copy of this *Notice of Child Abuse, Family Violence, or Risk of Family Violence (Current Case)* to the prescribed child welfare authority and may provide such other court documents and information as is required to enable investigation of the contents of the Notice.
